The healthcare system in Shanghai includes public hospitals, private hospitals, international hospitals or clinics for the foreigners (like Parkway and United Family Hospital). The public hospitals are the mainstream of healthcare system, divided into three levels: tertiary, secondly and primary care center, and some of them are combined into partnership. The application of IT, including AI and mobile Health helps the rapid evolving in Shanghai, for example, cloud/digital hospital. The medical cost and mode of payment also differ from each other. In general, it is acceptable for different kind of patients and there must be one pattern suitable for each person.
